DESTINATION SPOTLIGHT Dubrovnik, Croatia



Dubrovnik is a stunning coastal city in southern Croatia, located on the Adriatic Sea. Often referred to as the "Pearl of the Adriatic," it's famous for its medieval Old Town, surrounded by massive stone walls and filled with historic buildings, marble streets, and baroque charm.

Founded: 7th century as "Ragusa"

Golden Age: 15th–16th centuries, as a powerful maritime republic (like Venice)

Independence: Maintained independence through diplomacy and trade.

Suffered damage during the Croatian War of Independence (1991), but was beautifully restored.

Major Attractions

- 1. City Walls Walk the 2 km long walls for jaw-dropping views of the sea and roof-tops.
- 2. Old Town (Stari Grad) A UNESCO World Heritage Site Full of palaces, monasteries, fountains, and picturesque streets
- 3. Stradun (Placa)

The main street of the Old Town. Lined with shops, cafes, and beautiful architecture

- 4. Fort Lovrijenac A dramatic fortress perched on a cliff Nicknamed "Dubrovnik's Gibraltar"
- 5. Dubrovnik Cathedral & Churches Includes beautiful baroque and gothic-style churches. The cathedral supposedly has a relic of the True Cross.
- 6. Lokrum Island Just 10 minutes by boat

Beaches

Banje Beach: The most famous city beach with views of the Old Town

Sveti Jakov Beach: A bit quieter and equally beautiful Lapad Beach: Family-friendly and great for sunset

What to Eat:

Peka: Meat or seafood slow-cooked under a bell-like lid Rozata: A custard dessert similar to flan or crème brûlée

What to Drink:

Dingac Wine: From the Pelješac Peninsula, near Dubrovnik

Rakija: A strong fruit brandy, often homemade

Culture and Events

Dubrovnik Summer Festival (July–August): Music, dance, theatre performances throughout the city

Feast of St. Blaise (February): Dubrovnik's patron saint, celebrated with parades and festivities

Best Time to Visit: May–June or September–October (avoids summer crowds but still warm)

Currency: Euro (€)

Language: Croatian (but English is widely spoken)

Getting Around: Old Town is pedestrian-only. Use ferries, buses, or walk.

Pop Culture

Game of Thrones: King's Landing scenes filmed here (Fort Lovrijenac = Red Keep)

Star Wars: Some Episode VIII scenes shot in Dubrovnik

MEXICO ENTRY IMMIGRATION FORM - TOURIST CARD

IMPORTANT - ALL International Visitors to Mexico must obtain a Digital Tourist Card - NO EXCEPTIONS - The Tourist Card is issued depending on your citizenship, passport information, visa requirements, and airport of entry. Does not currently apply to travel by cruise ship. Car or by air at this time.

NEW ADVISORY 2024: Some airports require a PRINTED copy of your Tourist Card. See the link below to get instructions on how to download your Tourist Card and have it ready when requested.

Foreign citizens traveling to Mexico are issued an Official Entry Immigration Form (FMM) also known as Tourist Card. The online registration process is FREE, very convenient, straightforward, and to complete the process all you need is your passport and travel information. THE TOURIST CARD IS PER PERSON INCLUDING CHILDREN AND DIPLOMATIC PERSONNEL.

Some Mexican States, such as the State of Quintana Roo, have local requirements IN ADDITION to the Mexican Tourist Card. When you fill out the application online, you will get all the information regarding any local State requirements and how to make sure you have all the documents necessary. Please make sure you have all the Federal and State requirements prior to your arrival to Mexico.

Don't Wait Until The Last Minute - Make Sure You Have All Your Travel Documents Now!

WHO YOU ARE: You are a foreign citizen traveling to Mexico, have a valid passport, will not stay in Mexico more than 180 days, traveling to Mexico for pleasure, vacation, or recreational purposes, and are NOT going to Mexico to seek employment

FAO - Tourist Card

1. What is a Tourist Card and why I need it?

If you are visiting Mexico you need a Tourist Card which is an Entry Immigration Form that details information about your visit to Mexico. The Tourist Card is per person regardless of age and how long you will stay in Mexico. The information you provide in the Tourist Card is kept by the Mexican Immigration Authority as an official record of your visit to Mexico.

2. How much does it cost?

The Tourist Card is TOTALLY FREE. You don't have to pay anything to get your Tourist Card online.

3. Do I need to send my passport for inspection?

NO, you DO NOT need to send us your passport. On the application form we will ask you for the information we need from your passport in order to process your Tourist Card. When you land in Mexico you will be required to present your passport to the immigration officer so it can be stamped with the Official Entry Stamp.

Travel Insurance: Myths & Misconceptions

Traveling domestically for vacation or to visit family. Flying overseas for a bucket-list trip. Cruising the Caribbean. Accidents, illnesses, trip interruptions, cancellations, and travel emergencies can happen anytime, anywhere. It's in these situations that travel insurance can make all the difference.

Here, we deconstruct the top four myths and misconceptions about travel insurance and explain how it can play a critical role if your trip takes an unexpected turn.

Misconception #1

I have major medical insurance. That will always cover any medical expenses if I'm injured or sick while traveling.

Reality

Medical insurance may not cover medical expenses incurred while traveling outside of your network. Plus, many international medical providers and some providers in the U.S. require payment or guarantee of payment upfront before providing service.

When necessary, Chubb and our travel assistance team can issue upfront guarantee of payment to medical providers to ensure that covered travelers receive required care, helping minimize financial stress and delays.

Misconception #2

Travel emergencies are rare. And if I have an unexpected issue, I can troubleshoot on my own.

Reality

Travel emergencies and mishaps happen often. In fact, our travel assistance team fields thousands of calls per year from travelers facing unexpected issues. The majority of those calls are from travelers facing a medical emergency.

Travelers should also think beyond their own potential emergencies. For example, what if a family emergency takes place at home, requiring them to cut their trip short and find their way home immediately? Having 24/7 access to a network of experts to help find quality care, replace lost or missing medication, coordinate medical/security evacuations, or even research and coordinate changes in travel arrangements can prove invaluable.

Misconception #3

Delays, cancellations, or interruptions might happen. But if they do, the supplier (e.g., airline, cruise line, tour operator) will always reimburse me or cover my expenses.

Reality

Travelers often think that a supplier has to take care of issues that arise with regard to delays, cancellations, and interruptions. That may be true in some cases. However, those suppliers are not responsible in any way when it's a weather-related situation. They have absolutely no obligation to the traveler. When there's a weather-related situation, a travel insurance policy can fill this gap. For example, Chubb's travel insurance policies cover for weather-related cancellations, trip interruptions, and delayed connections.

Most suppliers also can't reimburse for trip interruptions that occur if a traveler has an emergency at home—like being at a loved one's side after an accident—that requires them to change their plans.

Misconception #4

I'll just purchase travel insurance directly from my travel supplier—there's no difference from working with a third-party insurance provider.

Reality

Purchasing travel insurance directly from your supplier (e.g., airline, cruise line, tour operator) is certainly an option. However, third-party travel insurance providers, like Chubb, can offer more comprehensive coverage and valuable travel assistance services.
